	<p><i>ATM Transfer:</i> You can pay the tuition fees via any local bank or post office ATMs with your Debit Card (not Credit Card)^(c):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Choose 'Other Service'2. Choose 'Bill Payment '3. Choose 'Normal Payment'4. Enter Bank ID '009'5. Enter the 14 digits as shown on your payment slip when the machine asks for the account number6. Enter the amount to be paid (there will be some warning messages about transferring money to other account, please choose 'yes' whenever this pops up)7. If the transfer is successful, it will show on the screen and tell you the process is completed. Please make sure to keep the receipt for future reference.
